In fact, every student has been given a mentor that can speak to their respective role on the project, whether that be design, production, audio, or engineering.

On Wednesday, Michael John, Senior Creative Director, ran a board game challenge with our team and our mentors. We broke into three groups and were given 2 hours to create a board game, doing two rounds of 30 minute design and 20 minute playtest. It was a great opportunity to get to know our client and to see how our team works as a group.

On Friday, Joe Sutton, the team's Networking mentor, ran us through several networking tutorials using javascript and node.js. These tutorials gave us many of the tools that we'll need to develop our game for the rest of the semester.

Our close proximity and relationship with the OCCO this semester will be a great help to us on the road to success. We are very excited to be working with them.
